Photographer, publisher, curator, teacher, and trained philologist, Juliusz Sokolowski has specialized in architectural and spatial photography for 17 years. Occasionally, he also captures portraits of individuals open to the idea of photography as a form of encounter.

He is the originator and curator of the acclaimed exhibition "Magnification. Photographs in Times of Hustle" (2002), where photography "competed" with the architecture of central Warsaw. This exhibition featured four photographs by four photographers displayed on the four walls of the Palace of Culture and Science, each spanning 1300 square meters.





Lodz Kaliska is a legendary avant-garde Polish artistic group that has been operating continuously since 1979. Known for its opposition to established principles and phenomena, the group's work is characterized by a neo-Dadaistic nature. The current members are Marek Janiak, Adam Rzepecki, Andrzej Swietlik, Andrzej Wielogorski, and Slawek Bit (since 2007), with Andrzej Kwietniewski contributing until 2007.

In the latter half of the 1980s, Lodz Kaliska began creating pastiche productions of renowned artworks. Through their photographs and films, they staged happenings that offered ironic commentary on artists and art history.
